2. CHARTERED AI ENGINEER PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATION

Chartered AI Engineer (CAIE) Professional Qualification to recognize and award credentials to students and working professionals with real-world industry experience in AI-related engineering roles. Please note this is not a course or academic qualification.

Chartered AI Engineer (CAIE) Professional Qualification validates the technical competencies and qualified work experiences of applicants and awards the title of 'Chartered AI Engineer" to those who pass the assessment, as listed in the Chartered AI Engineer (CAIE) Professional Qualification Handbook.

There are currently four (4) levels of professional qualifications in Chartered AI Engineer Professional Qualification:

1. Associate Al Engineer (Assoc Al Engineer)

2. Chartered AI Engineer Level 1 (CAIE L1)

3. Chartered AI Engineer Level 2 (CAIE L2)

4. Chartered AI Engineer Level 3 (CAIE L3)

3. ELIGIBILITY AND PREREQUISITES

The four professional qualifications levels for AI engineers are aligned with the competency requirements of different AI career profiles.

5. BENEFITS OF CHARTERED AI ENGINEER PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATION

The CAIE 1 and CAIE 2 qualification serves as a recognition of an AI engineer's current competency and experience in AI skills to develop and deploy AI projects that create positive social and economic impacts and promote the public good. As a CAIE 1 and 2, you will also be invited to be assessor ("CAIE Assessor") for new applicants to the CAIE professional qualification programme (as long as your qualification is valid), so that you can contribute to grow the AI talent pool in Singapore.

As a CAIE Assessor, you may be invited to assist AI Professionals Association (AIP) to review and interview applicants applying to be CAIE 1 / 2. This would entail using online collaboration tools to review applications that may contain confidential information which we trust will be used with utmost discretion.

The level of commitment shall be on a mutually agreed basis.

6. DISPLAY OF CREDENTIALS

All CAIE qualified engineers will be allowed to display their qualification credentials and the CAIE professional qualification logo on their business card, email signature and other corporate marketing materials. Any display of the CAIE professional qualification logo must adhere to the style guide which will be sent to all successful qualified candidates.

7. VALIDITY OF THE PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATION AND RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

All Chartered Al Engineers and Associate Al Engineers, with the exception of CAIE 3, are required to submit qualification renewal to ensure that their knowledge, skills and experience remain current. The requirements for renewal are detailed below:

The personal data collected by AI Professionals Association will be used for the purposes of managing and administering the Professional Qualification, assessment and may be disclosed to partners, service providers, supporting Singapore Government bodies of AI Professionals Association and appointed CAIE Assessors on a need to know basis. By accepting our offer to the Qualification, you consent to AI Professionals Association sharing your data for the above purposes.

9. UPDATE CONTACT INFORMATON

You shall inform and update AI Professionals Association, as soon as practicable, of any changes to your contact details during the professional qualification validity period. The contact details will include telephone, email and postal address of the current place of residence. This is to ensure that AIP is able to reach you in future in order to invite you as a CAIE Assessor or to keep you posted on any updates to the professional qualification.

10. CHANGES AND MODIFICATIONS

Al Professionals Association reserve the right to make changes to the schedule and content for the professional qualification without prior notice.



11. CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

"Confidential Information" means any device, graphics, written information, data or information in any other form that is disclosed by AI Professionals Association to you for the purposes of the Qualification, which is marked at the time of disclosure as being "Confidential" or "Proprietary" or with words of similar import. You shall not disclose any Confidential Information that you have acquired during the Qualification with any third parties without the prior written consent of AI Professionals Association.
